GoGreen: Green Strategies to Conserve the Past and Preserve the Future of Cultural Heritage

The GoGreen project aims to:

- define what “**green**” means in conservation.
- develop **preventive conservation** practices and a ‘green thinking’ **decision-making model**.
- develop **green materials and methods** inspired by historical recipes and methods, biological processes and green chemistry practices.
- create a prototype **digital web-app** that helps conservators evaluate the environmental impact of their actions
- create **policies** for the use of green conservation in the field
- **Education modules** and **course material** for stakeholders on green conservation.
